	<ul> <li>Judean religionists and their Temple guards</li> </ul>	Mark 14:43-52
	- Judas betrays him with a kiss	Luke 22:47-53
	- Peter cuts the ear of the high priest's servant; Jesus heals him	John 18:2-12
	<ul> <li>Jesus gives himself to the soldiers and they bind him</li> </ul>	
	- All disciples forsake him and flee

	- Appears before Annas late Monday night	John 18:13-23
	- Peter denies Jesus for the first time

	<ul> <li>The first trial of Jesus before the High Priest</li> </ul>	Matt 26:57-75
	<ul> <li>Caiaphas and the Sanhedrin</li> </ul>	Mark 14:53-72
	<ul> <li>Find Jesus guilty and sentence him to death</li> </ul>	Luke 22:54-65
	• They spit on him	John 18:24-27
	<ul> <li>They put a covering over his head</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>They beat him with their fists and thin rods</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>They mock him; "Prophesy who is beating you"</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Peter (outside) denies Jesus 5 more times</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Peter sees his masters beaten face</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>About 1:30 AM Tuesday</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Jesus accused and questioned again</li> </ul>	Mark 15:1
	<ul> <li>Once again he is convicted and sentenced to death</li> </ul>	Luke 26:66-71
8.	Appears before Pilate – Early Tuesday morning	
	<ul> <li>Religious leaders accuse Jesus</li> </ul>	Matt 27:2
	<ul> <li>Pilate finds no fault</li> </ul>	Mark 15:1
	<ul> <li>Pilate sends Jesus to Herod</li> </ul>	Luke 23:1-6

9.	Appears before Herod – Tuesday morning	
	<ul> <li>Herod mocks Jesus wanting to see a miracle</li> </ul>	Luke 23:7-12
	<ul> <li>Dresses him in royal garments and sends him back to Pilate</li> </ul>	
10.	. Second appearance before Pilate – Late Tuesday morning	
	<ul> <li>Pilate questions Jesus and takes the issue to the people</li> </ul>	Matt 27:11-25
	<ul> <li>The people insist on releasing the murder Barabbas, not Jesus</li> </ul>	Mark 15:2-14
	<ul> <li>Pilate has Jesus scourged by Roman soldiers</li> </ul>	Luke 23:13-23
	<ul> <li>Stripped and tied to a stake</li> </ul>	John 18:39-19:15
	<ul> <li>Brutally flogged with a whip with bone or metal at the end</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Beaten with rods and a crown of thorns was pressed onto</li> </ul>	his head
	<ul> <li>Pilate parades him before the people</li> </ul>	
11.	. Sentenced by Pilate around noon Tuesday	
	<ul> <li>Pilate washes hands of responsibility</li> </ul>	Matt 27:26
	<ul> <li>Judean leaders readily accept</li> </ul>	Mark 15:15

12. Tortured and Mocked by Roman Soldiers

<ul> <li>400 to 600 soldiers mock and beat him</li> </ul>	Matt 27:26-31
<ul> <li>Sundown begins the 14<sup>th</sup> of Nisan</li> </ul>	Mark 15:15-20
<ul> <li>Jesus is stripped of his clothes again, ripping off scabs and dried blood</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Another crown of thorns is placed on his head and beaten into his skull</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Jesus is mocked as a king and given a reed for a scepter</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>The soldiers take the reed and beat him with it</li> </ul>	
13. Led to Golgotha	
<ul> <li>Jesus is dressed in his own clothes again, tearing open wounds</li> </ul>	Matt 27:32-34
<ul> <li>Soldiers drag Jesus and Simon of Cyrene carries his cross</li> </ul>	Mark 15:20-23
<ul> <li>Two malefactors are led with him</li> </ul>	Luke 23:26-32
<ul> <li>Jesus refuses the first of many painkillers offered</li> </ul>	John 19:16, 17
14. The Crucifixion – Approximately between 9 AM and 3 PM	
<ul> <li>Jesus nailed to a tree with the malefactors on either side</li> </ul>	Matt 27:35-49
<ul> <li>The crowd mocks and one malefactor reviles him</li> </ul>	Mark 15:24-36
<ul> <li>Breathing is almost impossible. There are terrible cramps and spasms</li> </ul>	Luke 23:33-46
<ul> <li>Nails driven through the hands and feet severing nerves and tendons</li> </ul>	John 19:18-30
<ul> <li>Then two robbers are crucified , making 5 total</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>"My God, my God, for this purpose was I spared"</li> </ul>	
15. His death – About 3 PM Wednesday the 14 <sup>th</sup> of Nisan	
<ul> <li>Jesus states "It is finished"</li> </ul>	Matt 27:50-54
